**ORDER** 

The Court has reviewed the Proposed Findings and Recommended Disposition submitted by United States Magistrate Judge Joe J. Volpe and the parties' objections. made a substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right. 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(1)-(2). The

Court finds no issue on which Mr. Haag has made a substantial showing of a denial of a

constitutional right. Thus, the certificate of appealability is denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Mr. Haag's Petition (Doc. No. 2) is DISMISSED. The

requested relief is denied and any pending motions are denied as moot.
