ORDER

United States Magistrate Judge Beth Deere entered a recommended disposition on March 29, 2012, recommending that the petition for writ of habeas corpus filed by Charles Edward Jones be dismissed with prejudice. On April 20, 2012, the Court entered an order adopting that recommendation and dismissing the petition with prejudice. On April 24, 2012, the Court received from Jones a motion for extension of time within which to file objections.
