<u>ORDER</u>

The proposed findings and recommended disposition submitted by United States Magistrate Judge H. David Young have been reviewed. 4. The court certifies that an *in forma pauperis* appeal taken from the order and judgment dismissing this action is considered frivolous and not in good faith.
