## <u>ORDER</u>

Plaintiff filed an amended complaint on May 29, 2012, and service was ordered. 2. Nash's last known address shall not be made part of any public record.

3. The Clerk of the Court shall prepare a summons for Nash, and the United States Marshal is hereby directed to serve a copy of the summons and amended complaint (docket entry #9), and this order, on Nash, at the address provided under seal, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor.

4. Upon re-issuance of the summons and complaint, the United States Marshal is hereby
