ORDER

The Court has considered Magistrate Judge H. David Young's proposed findings and recommendations, *No. 20*, Jones's objections, *No. 21*, and his motion for appointed counsel, *No. 22*. It's unclear what steps Jones has taken to find a lawyer, and his claims are neither factually nor legally complex. *Ward v. Smith*, 721 F.3d 940, 942 (8th Cir. 2013). Motion, *No. 22*, denied. On *de novo* review, the Court adopts the proposed decision. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). Defendants' motion for summary judgment, *No. 15*, is granted. Jones's complaint is dismissed with prejudice. The Court certifies that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order and the related Judgment would not be taken in good faith.
