<u>ORDER</u>

- 2. Defendant Troy Moore is dismissed without prejudice from this action due to lack of service.
- 3. The Court certifies, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order would not be taken in good faith.
