ORDER

The proposed findings and recommended disposition submitted by United States Magistrate Judge Joe J. Volpe and the Petitioner's objections thereto have been reviewed. As there is no issue on which Fowler has made a substantial showing of a denial of a constitutional right, a certificate of appealability is denied.
