ORDER

Magistrate Judge H. David Young denied Kennedy's motion to compel Defendants to produce copies of his medical records because Kennedy can review the records upon request, and because the records will be brought to any hearing. *No. 55*. Kennedy's motion for reconsideration, *No. 57*, is denied. Discovery must be limited if a Court determines that it may be obtained from a source that is more convenient, or less burdensome or expensive. FED. R. CIV. P. 26(b)(2)(C). Judge Young's order is not clearly erroneous or contrary to law. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A); Local Rule 72.1.VII.B
