ORDER

The proposed findings and partial recommended disposition ("PRD") submitted by United States Magistrate Judge H. David Young and plaintiff's objections thereto have been reviewed. 2. Defendants Adams and Clark are dismissed as parties.

3. Quarles's motion for a directed verdict [Doc. No. 32] and Briggs's motion to dismiss [Doc. No. 47] are denied.
