ORDER

The proposed findings and recommended disposition (“RD”) submitted by United States Magistrate Judge J. Thomas Ray and petitioner Antonio Robinson’s objections thereto have been reviewed. The petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 [Doc. No. 1] filed by Antonio Robinson is dismissed with prejudice, and his motion for declaratory judgment [Doc. As there is no issue on which Robinson has made a substantial showing of a denial of a constitutional right, a certificate of appealability is denied. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(1)-(2).
