## **ORDER**

The proposed findings and partial recommended disposition submitted by United States Magistrate Judge Thomas J. Ray and plaintiff's objections thereto have been received. - 2. The clerk of court shall prepare summons for defendant Peppers and the United States Marshal shall serve a copy of the complaint [Doc. No. 3] and summons on her without prepayment of fees and costs or security.
- 3. Defendants Marvin Hughey and Alva M. Green are dismissed without prejudice for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.
  - 4. It is certified, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an in forma pauperis

appeal from this order would not be taken in good faith.

5. Plaintiff's motion to amend/correct his objection [Doc. No. 28] is denied as moot.
