ORDER

The Court has given Ellis plenty of time to pay the filing fee, N_2 13 & 18. Ellis has not done so. Based on lack of access to library materials, he asks for more time to respond on the merits of whether he is a 3–striker. That motion, N_2 21, is denied. Ellis's status is clear.
