ORDER

The Court has reviewed the Proposed Findings and Recommended Disposition submitted by United States Magistrate Judge Joe J. Volpe and plaintiff's objections. 1. Defendants' motion for summary judgment is GRANTED. Document #68.

2. Plaintiff's remaining claims against defendants Brown, Watson, Budnik, Bolden, Stephens, Washington, Kelley, Reed, Jackson, Harris, and Hobbs are DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE, except that his negligence claims are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

3. Plaintiff's cause of action is DISMISSED.

4. The Court certifies, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order adopting the recommendations and the accompanying Judgment would not be taken in good faith.
