ORDER

1. Rankin filed a motion for an extension of time to object, but has objected twice since then. *No. 8 & 9*. The motion, *No. 7*, is denied as moot.

2. On *de novo* review, the Court adopts the recommendation, *No. 6*, as supplemented, and overrules Rankin's objections, *No. 8 & 9*. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). Magistrate Judge Volpe correctly concluded that Rankin's complaint fails to state a claim against any of the defendants. He also directed Rankin to provide any more information that would bolster his allegations. *No. 6 at 4*. Rankin has now explained how he believes each defendant was involved. *No. 8 & 9*. Even with these clarifications, though, Rankin fails to state a claim against any of the defendants. His complaint will therefore be

dismissed without prejudice. This dismissal counts as a "strike" for purposes of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). An *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order and accompanying Judgment would not be taken in good faith. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3).
