Crockett has filed another Rule 60(b) motion. *Doc. 13.* He argues that the law has changed since his 2017 Rule 60 motion and that the Judgment in his *habeas* case should therefore be vacated. And this new motion is aimed at unwinding the *habeas* Judgment; it doesn't warrant relief from the 2018 Judgment and final Order in this case. *Doc. 8 & 9.* Crockett's new motion, *Doc. 13,* is therefore denied without prejudice to his filing it in his *habeas* case if he so chooses.
