ORDER

I have reviewed the Recommendation submitted by United States Magistrate Judge J.

The U.S. Marshal is directed to serve the summons, substituted complaint, and this Order on her without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor.

All claims against Clark, Swopes, Treas, Reed, Evans, Cashion, Watson, Payne, and Does are dismissed without prejudice. The motion for temporary restraining order or a preliminary injunction (Doc. No. 8) is DENIED. I certify that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order would not be taken in good faith.²
