IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that:



Watson, Gibson, Emsweller, McHan, Cashion, Budnik, Bolden, R. Johnson, Claudia Harris, Stephens, Brown, Plumer, Easaw, F. Washington, Demery, Fooks, Spencer, Dock King, Pittman, G. Thompson, Evans, and Felicia Piggee.
2. All other claims are DISMISSED from this action without prejudice.
3. Defendants Rory Griffin, Jason Kelley, Correct Care Solutions, Stringfellow, and Day1 are DISMISSED from this action without prejudice.
