Now on this 28th day of July 2009, comes for consideration the Report and Recommendation

dated July 8, 2009, by the Honorable Barry A. Bryant, United States Magistrate Judge for the Western District of Arkansas. Ten (10) days have passed without objections being filed by the parties. (d)(2)(G).
