ORDER

Now on this 10th day of February 2012, there comes on for consideration Plaintiff's *pro se* motion requesting the Court to reconsider its order adopting the Magistrate's report and recommendation, denying his motion for leave to proceed IFP and dismissing his case as the claims asserted are frivolous, fail to state claims upon which relief may be granted, or are not cognizable.
