ORDER

On December 28, 2012, Plaintiff submitted a complaint for filing in this district, together with a request for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* (“IFP”). ECF Nos. 1, 2. Defendant is ordered to answer within sixty (60) days from the date of service.
