**MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER**

Plaintiff, Gina Gilbreath, brings this action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) seeking judicial review of a decision of the Commissioner of Social Security (“Commissioner”). ECF No. 1. On March 13, 2017, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Dismiss. ECF No. 10. Having received an Order remanding case number 16-2278 pursuant to sentence six of 42 U.S.C. 405(g), Plaintiff agrees that the instant case covers a duplicate time period and is satisfied that the sentence six remand in that case will include a review of the medical evidence relevant to this case.
