ORDER

Astrue, Commissioner, Social Security Administration, as well as Eric H. Holder, Jr., U.S. Attorney General, and Mark W. Webb, Assistant U.S. Attorney, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor. Defendant is ordered to answer within sixty (60) days from the date of service.
