ORDER

The order should be sent to him by certified mail, return receipt requested. The Clerk should also send a copy of the IFP application (prisoner form) in case the prior applications cannot be located. Jail Administrator Day is asked to assist the Plaintiff by completing the jail account certification part of the application. The application should be returned to this Court by no later than **July 26, 2013**.
