ORDER

Currently before the Court is Plaintiff's *pro se* filing, in which Plaintiff states that he is resubmitting his application request; requests "all documents and materials stolen in Dallas in June 2005;" and, finally, requests "an extention [sic] and if necessary a change in venue." The Clerk of Court is directed not to accept any future filings in this case. Plaintiff is advised that any documents sent by Plaintiff to be filed in this case will not be filed of record or considered by the Court.
