ORDER

Currently before the Court is the Report and Recommendation (Doc. 56) of the Honorable James R. Marschewski, Chief United States Magistrate Judge for the Western District of Arkansas. The Magistrate recommends granting Plaintiff Jimmy D. Stevens' twin Motions to Dismiss (Docs. 53, 54), both of which ask that the case be voluntarily dismissed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2).
