Mary,

Responding to your inquiries--

Q: Could you get me either the statute or congressional act that established that full time position?

Magistrate Judge Barry A. Bryant was appointed to the **full-time magistrate judge position in the Western District of Arkansas** authorized in September 1991. The authorization follows:

A: The Report of the Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States, September 23-24, 1991,

"a. Authorized an additional full-time magistrate judge position at Hot Springs or El Dorado or Texarkana;
b. discontinued the part-time magistrate judge positions at Hot Springs, Harrison, and El Dorado upon the appointment of the new full-time magistrate judge at Hot Springs or El Dorado or Texarkana; and
c. made no change in the full-time magistrate judge position at Fort Smith."
pursuant to the recommendation of the Committee on the Administration of the Magistrate Judges System at its meeting in June 1991.

This approved request was a renewal by the Western District of Arkansas following its original request declined by the Committee on the Administration of the Magistrate Judges System at its meeting in December 1990.

In addition, Magistrate Judge Barry A. Bryant was appointed to the **full-time magistrate judge position authorized to serve in the adjoining Eastern District of Texas** in September 1993. The authorization is below:

A: The Report of the Judicial Conference of the United States, September 20, 1993,

"Authorized the full-time magistrate judge position at Hot Springs or El Dorado or Texarkana in the Western District of Arkansas to serve in the adjoining Eastern District of Texas",
pursuant to the recommendation of the Committee on the Administration of the Magistrate Judges System at its meeting in June 1993.
