

DISQUALIFICATION ORDER

The undersigned began active service with the Court on March 10, 2014. The captioned matters were reassigned to this division on or about March 17, 2014. On March 28, 2014, the undersigned provided written disclosure to the parties of certain facts and circumstances which would require disqualification pursuant to 28 USC §455 (Doc No. 90).
