ORDER

Before the Court is the Report and Recommendation filed June 18, 2013 by the Honorable Barry A. Bryant, United States Magistrate Judge for the Western District of Arkansas. (ECF No. 10). This action involves an appeal of a decision by the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration to deny Plaintiff certain disability benefits. Judge Bryant recommends that the ALJ's decision to deny Plaintiff such benefits be reversed and remanded because it is not supported by substantial evidence.
