**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Before the Court is Defendant's Motion to Remand. ECF No. 13. Defendant filed this Motion on April 29, 2014. *Id.* Plaintiff has responded to this Motion and has no objections to this Motion. ECF No. 14. The Parties have consented to the jurisdiction of a magistrate judge to conduct any and all proceedings in this case, including conducting the trial, ordering the entry of a final judgment, and conducting all post-judgment proceedings. With this Motion, Defendant seeks a remand pursuant to Sentence 4 of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further administrative proceedings. ECF No. 13.
