ORDER

Before the Court is the parties' Motion to Stay Pending Settlement Discussions. (ECF No. 32). The parties have now informed the Court that a stay remains necessary, as they have made significant progress toward settling a portion of the claims pending in these cases. Accordingly, the motion should be and hereby is GRANTED. This action is stayed for a period of ninety (90) days.
