ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant's Motion to File Redacted Portions of Its Memorandum in Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Class Certification and to File Certain Confidential Exhibits Under Seal. (ECF No. 48). On October 30, 2014, the Court entered a Stipulated Protective Order. (ECF No. 28). Pursuant to the Order, documents regarding claims submitted by Defendant's insureds and Defendant's proprietary information were to be marked "Confidential." Defendant is directed to file its Response redacted on the docket. Defendant is further directed to provide the Court with an unredacted copy of the Response.
