**ORDER**

interest properly joined and served as defendants is a citizen of the State in which such action is

brought." 28 USC § 1441(b)(2). Defendants do not dispute Plaintiff's assertion that remand is

appropriate.

After consideration, the Court finds that Plaintiff's Motion to Remand (ECF No. 10) should

be and hereby is **GRANTED**, and this action is hereby remanded to the Circuit Court of Hempstead

County, Arkansas for proper adjudication of the issues in this case.
