

ORDER

Now before the Court is the Report and Recommendation (Doc. 8) of the Honorable Erin L. Setser, Magistrate Judge for the Western District of Arkansas. Plaintiff has also filed an Objection (Doc. 9), which has triggered the Court's *de novo* review.
