**ORDER**

On June 3, 2021, Plaintiff filed a Complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) seeking judicial review of a decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration. (Doc. 2). The Defendant is ordered to answer within sixty (60) days from the date of service.
