ORDER

Before the Court is a Motion to Withdraw and Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 8) filed on behalf of Plaintiff and Plaintiff's counsel. Due to a conflict of interest, Plaintiff's counsel, Luther O'Neal Sutter, requests that he be allowed to withdraw as counsel for Plaintiff.
