6 The Court having considered Judgment Creditor Plaintiff NATIONAL
7 INTEGRATED TECHNOLOGIES, INC. (“NITI”) Application for and Renewal
8 of Judgment against Judgment Debtors ROBERT GUSTAVSON (“Gustavson”)
9 and PROTECTION SYSTEMS, INC. (“PSI) hereby GRANTS the application as
10 follows:
11

13 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

14 1. That the Judgment Creditor NITI’s original judgment entered on
15 January 12, 2005, against Judgment Debtors Robert Gustavson, jointly and
16 severally, and Protection Systems, Inc., jointly and severally, is hereby renewed
17 in the following amount:
18

20 Economic Damages: \$385,687.00

21 Interest after judgment: \$305,450.25 (Calculated: \$385,687.00 x 5.28%
22 = \$59.77/day x 5475 days (15 years) = \$305,450.25)

24 Attorneys’ Fees/Costs: \$183,031.50

26 Punitive Damages \$15,000.00

3 **TOTAL: \$904,168.75**

5 2. That the terms of the Stipulated Judgment set forth below are
6 hereby renewed:

7 (1) That Plaintiff NITI have judgment against Defendants Gustavson
8 and PSI, jointly and severally, for economic damages in the sum of \$385,687.00
9 for rescission based on fraud and conversion, with interest thereon at the rate of
10 5.28% per annum from September 15, 1999;

11
12 (2) That Plaintiff NITI's breach of contract cause of action is
13 dismissed;

14
15 (3) That Defendant PSI is the owner of the remaining LA 2000 Light
16 Alarm Systems that were in Defendant PSI's possession at the time of the trial;

17
18 (4) That, based on a finding of fraud, malice, and oppression, punitive
19 damages be awarded against Gustavson in the amount of \$15,000.00;

20
21 (5) That, based on a finding of fraud, malice, and oppression, punitive
22 damages be awarded against PSI in the amount of \$15,000.00;

23
24 (6) That the preliminary injunction, issued by this Court on September
25 19, 1997, enjoining Defendant PSI and its officers, agents, servants, employees,
26 attorneys of record, and those acting in concert or participation with them, from
27

1 selling or otherwise disposing of 1,500 units of the LA 2000 Light Alarm
2 Systems is dissolved;

3
4 (7) That Defendants and Counter-Complainants, Gustavson and PSI,
5 take nothing by way of their Counterclaim; and

6
7 (8) That Defendants Gustavson and PSI shall be obligated, jointly and
8 severally, to pay Plaintiff NITI the amount of \$183,031.50 in attorneys' fees and
9 costs.
