
JUDGMENT

1 This action was previously stayed pending completion of the ex-parte
2 reexamination of United States Patent No. 6,137,794 by the United States Patent and
3 Trademark Office, Proceeding Number 90/007,802. The reexamination proceeding,
4 including all appeals relating thereto, having now been concluded,

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

- 6 1. Judgment is hereby rendered in favor of Plaintiff/Counterdefendant RGB
7 Systems, Inc. for the reasons set forth by the United States Circuit Court of
8 Appeals for the Federal Circuit in its final decision affirming the United
9 States Patent and Trademark Office's determination of the invalidity of all
10 claims of United States Patent No. 6,137,794 in said ex-parte reexamination
11 proceedings, Federal Circuit Case Number 2011-1119;
- 12 2. Defendant/Counter-claimant SP Controls, Inc. shall take nothing on its
13 counterclaim for patent infringement and said counterclaim is hereby
14 dismissed with prejudice; and
- 15 3. Plaintiff/Counterdefendant RGB Systems, Inc. is entitled to recover costs
16 and fees in an amount that has been agreed to by the parties, with said
17 amount already having been fully satisfied by SP Controls, Inc.
