ORDER VACATING APRIL 16, 2007  
HEARING ON DISCOVERY  
MOTIONS

According to the "Stipulation Re: Scheduling Order and Order Thereon," filed March 20, 2007, prior orders of the Court established the discovery cut-off for non-expert discovery in this case at November 17, 2006. The Stipulation contains a recitation that "the parties have met and conferred on certain discovery disputes, and have initiated the joint stipulation process on four separate discovery motions, the rulings on which may require additional discovery responses or depositions," but the order on the stipulation extends only the deadline for expert discovery, not the deadline for non-expert discovery. Accordingly, the period for discovery having been closed, any potential relief from motions to compel would violate the cut-off imposed by the Court. Absent leave of court from Judge Larson to conduct discovery beyond the cut-off, therefore, the matters listed below cannot proceed.

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The Court orders the following motions off calendar:

- (1) Defendants' Motion to Compel Production of Whistle-Blower Documents;
- (2) Defendants' Motion to Compel Third Party Kevin Marks and Plaintiff Laura Siegel Larson to Answer Questions at Deposition;
- (3) Defendants' Motion to Compel Third Parties Kevin Marks and Gang, Tyre, Ramer & Brown, Inc. To Produce Documents Relating to Authority; and
- (4) Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Defendants to Answer Plaintiffs' Special Interrogatories.
