**[PROPOSED] ORDER MODIFYING PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Having considered the parties' arguments in the Joint Stipulation on Google Inc.'s Motion for Partial Reconsideration of Protective Order to Designate One Category of Documents Outside Counsel's Eyes Only (the "Motion"), and good cause having been shown, Google's Motion is hereby GRANTED, as follows:

1. Google's documents control numbered GGL 033446-033524, and any other documents Google may later produce regarding image recognition technology software, are hereby designated as "Outside Counsel's Eyes Only." Access to these documents is limited to outside counsel of record only. Access by any officer, employee, or agent of (1) plaintiff Perfect 10, Inc. (including Norman Zada) or (2) any defendant in the consolidated action, is hereby prohibited.

2. All documents designated as "Outside Counsel's Eyes Only" pursuant to this Order shall be subject to all provisions of, and considered as produced pursuant to, the December 27, 2005 Protective Order (including but not limited to the provisions regarding disposition of documents upon termination of the litigation).
