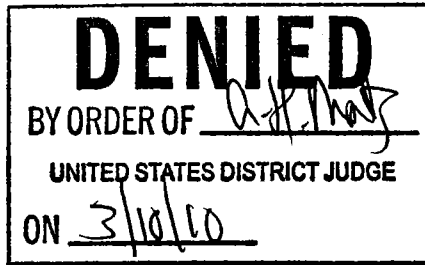
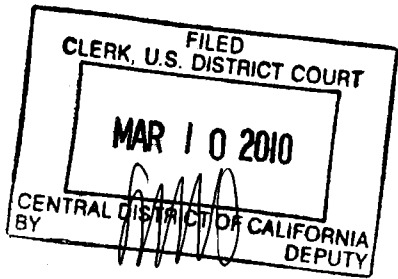

1 **[Proposed] Order**

2 Having reviewed the parties' submissions regarding Defendant Google Inc.'s  
3 *ex parte* application to strike Plaintiff Perfect 10, Inc.'s Motion for Preliminary  
4 Injunction Against Defendant Google Inc. (Dkt. No. 772) ("Second PI Motion") and  
5 for sanctions, and good cause having been shown, it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT  
6 Google's *ex parte* application is GRANTED, as follows:

- 7 1. Perfect 10's Second PI Motion is hereby STRICKEN from the record.  
8 2. The hearing on the Second PI Motion, currently set for April 5, 2010, is  
9 hereby VACATED.  
10 3. Google shall have no obligation to respond to the Second PI Motion  
11 unless directed to do so by further order of the Court.  
12 4. The Court finds that Perfect 10's Second PI Motion was filed in  
13 violation of the Court's July 8, 2009 Order, and that the Court's previous admonitions  
14 to Perfect 10 regarding unauthorized filings have gone unheeded. Accordingly, to  
15 discourage any such unauthorized filings in the future by Perfect 10, Perfect 10 is  
16 hereby SANCTIONED in the amount of \$10,000, payable to the Court within ten  
17 (10) days of the date of this Order.
