1	appeal is an event of jurisdictional significance—it confers jurisdiction on the court of
2	appeals and divests the district court of its control over those aspects of the case
3	involved in the appeal." Griggs v. Provident Consumer Discount Co., 459 U.S. 56, 58
4	(1982). Because petitioners's motion to disqualify Judges Gutierrez, Kenton, and
5	Olguin focuses on their handling of the merits of petitioner's case, petitioner's appeal
6	divested this Court of jurisdiction over the motion to disqualify. Accordingly, the
7	motion is hereby DENIED without prejudice, subject to renewal after resolution of
8	petitioner's appeal.
