Presently before the court is Plaintiff Margarita Valencia's 18 Motion to Enforce Settlement. On September 25, 2007, the court 19 20 dismissed Plaintiff's action, pursuant to a stipulation of the 21 parties. (Dkt. No. 28.) The parties agreed that Plaintiff would 22 submit written requests regarding her teaching schedule and that 23 Defendant's representative would meet with Plaintiff to review the 24 feasability of those request. (Id. at 2.) The parties agreed that 25 Plaintiff would be eligible to apply for a certain work status, 26 pursuant to a collective bargaining agreement. (Id. at 3.)

In the instant motion, Plaintiff asserts that Defendant's havebreached the agreement. Plaintiff asks that the court enforce the

1	agreement by granting her "a stable one semester of work until
2	12/31/13 for medical benefits or a Golden Hand Shake for one
3	semester of salary with no work." (Mot. at 6.) The relief
4	Plaintiff seeks is neither provided for nor contemplated by the
5	settlement agreement. Plaintiff's motion is, therefore, DENIED.
