3 122. MISHAK incorporates herein by reference each and every allegation contained in  
4 paragraphs 1 through 121 with the same force and effect as if here fully set forth.

5 123. Many of the Plaintiff's customers regularly purchase products from MISHAK's  
6 website, and are repeat customers. It is probable that such customers and others will continue to  
7 seek to visit MISHAK's website and purchase Plaintiff's goods and services in the future.

8 124. Upon information and belief, Defendants were aware of the existence of  
9 Plaintiff's reasonable expectation of future transactions with Plaintiff's returning customers, as  
10 well as consumers who may be attracted to Plaintiff's goods and services as a result of Plaintiff's  
11 goodwill and extensive advertising and promotion.

12 125. Absent Defendants' intentional and improper interference through their deceptive  
13 and manipulated search engine "results," it is reasonably certain that Plaintiff would realize  
14 additional sales from existing customers and/or new customers.

15 126. Defendants have intentionally or negligently and improperly interfered with  
16 Plaintiff's future and prospective sales through the Defendants' conduct; namely, their deceptive  
17 and manipulated search engine "results" that divert consumers from Plaintiff's websites.

18 127. The aforesaid acts of Defendants have caused and, unless said acts are restrained  
19 by this Court, via a Preliminary Injunction and Permanent Injunction will continue to cause  
20 MISHAK to suffer irreparable injury.

21 128. MISHAK has no adequate remedy at law. Damages at law are inadequate.  
22 Plaintiff seeks equitable relief from this Court.

2 WHEREFORE, as to all counts of this Complaint, Defendants will continue its unlawful  
3 activities unless enjoined and Plaintiff's remedy at law is inadequate; and

5 (A) A preliminary and a permanent injunction prohibiting Defendants and their  
6 officers, partners, agents, subcontractors, servants, employees, subsidiaries, and related  
7 companies or entities, and all others acting in concert or participating with them from:

- 8 1. Directly or indirectly selling or offering for sale advertising keywords that  
9 are identical or substantially similar to the MISHAK Marks, which are  
10 likely to cause consumer confusion, mistake, or deception with respect to  
11 the MISHAK Marks;  
12  
13 2. Continuing to post listing for MISHAK's competitors when Internet users  
14 run a search on Defendants' search engines using keywords that are  
15 identical or substantially similar to the MISHAK Marks;  
16  
17 3. Requiring Defendants to immediately contact all current advertisers who  
18 have purchased keywords identical or substantially similar to the  
19 MISHAK Marks and/or terms confusingly similar thereto, to inform them  
20 that the advertisers' links will no longer appear when an Internet user runs  
21 a search for a term that is identical or substantially similar to the MISHAK  
22 Marks;

24 4. Making any use of the MISHAK Marks and/or terms confusingly similar  
25 thereto;

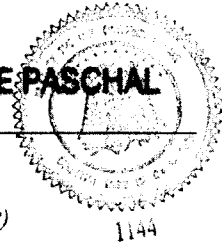
