Proceedings: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE DISMISSAL FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH DISCOVERY OBLIGATIONS

The Court has reviewed defendants’ July 6, 2018 Motion to Compel Deposition of Plaintiff. (Docket No. 270.) Defendants assert that plaintiff failed to appear for his properly noticed (and agreed upon continued date) for his deposition.
