9 On November 17, 2008, this Court granted the Motion of defendants Chase
10 Home Finance LLC (“Chase”), JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., erroneously sued as JP
11 Morgan Chase Bank (“JPMorgan”), and U.S. Bank National Association, Trustee for
12 Lehman Brothers Structured Asset Securities Corporation SASCO 2006-BC2,
13 erroneously sued as U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee for Lehman Brothers
14 Securities Corporation (“USBank,” collectively Defendants”) to Dismiss the Second
15 Amended Complaint of plaintiffs Bruce Hadley and Stephanie Y. Hadley (collectively
16 “Plaintiffs” or “Hadleys”). The Court found that Plaintiffs cannot state any claim
17 against Defendants because Plaintiffs' claims are barred by res judicata.

18 IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Plaintiffs' Second
19 Amended Complaint is dismissed with prejudice as to Chase, JPMorgan, and
20 USBank. The Court orders that Judgment is entered in favor of Chase, JPMorgan, and
21 USBank and against Plaintiffs, and each of them.
