



1 that Defendant Domino's Pizza, LLC failed to pay Plaintiff unpaid  
2 overtime wages, in violation of California Labor Code Sections 510  
3 and 1194. Therefore, Defendant Domino's Pizza, LLC owes Plaintiff  
4 Yolanda Crews \$48,680.77, plus 10% interest of \$23,481.01.

5 (3) The Court finds in favor of Defendant Domino's Pizza, LLC on Claim  
6 Three.

7 (4) The Court finds in favor of Defendant Domino's Pizza, LLC on Claim  
8 Four.

9 (5) The Court finds in favor of Plaintiff Yolanda Crews on Claim Five  
10 that Plaintiff was unable to take uninterrupted meal breaks as required  
11 by California Labor Code Section 226.7. Therefore, the Court grants  
12 damages to Plaintiff in the amount of \$19,654.04, plus 10% interest of  
13 \$8,324.79.

14 (6) The Court finds in favor of Plaintiff Yolanda Crews on Claim Six, a  
15 violation of California Business & Professions Code Section 17200.

16 (7) The Court finds in favor of Plaintiff on Claim Seven.

18 The Court concludes that the Plaintiff Yolanda Crews is the prevailing party  
19 in her action against Defendant Domino's Pizza, LLC.
