| On July 13, 2009, the parties filed a joint status report stating that they "will file Cross Motions for Summary Judgment by or on August 3, 2009," on the issue of whether plaintiffs are eligible for the waiver available under 8 U.S.C. § 1225(k). As stated in this Court's standard Scheduling and Case Management Order, parties shall avoid filing cross-motions for summary judgment on identical issues of law, such that the papers would be unnecessarily cumulative. The Court thus ORDERS that only Plaintiffs may move for summary judgment. They shall do so on or before August 3, 2009.
