This action having been commenced on March 2, 2009, and the Court having granted plaintiffs’ motion for entry of judgment against defendant, Smith-Emery Company, a California corporation, and the Court having found and concluded in

1 accordance with its order that the parties to this action have entered into a settlement of  
2 this action, and good cause appearing therefor.

3 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that Plaintiffs,  
4 Trustees of the Operating Engineers Pension Trust, Trustees of the Operating Engineers  
5 Health and Welfare Fund, Trustees of the Operating Engineers Vacation-Holiday  
6 Savings Trust and Trustees of the Operating Engineers Training Trust shall recover  
7 from defendant Smith-Emery Company, a California corporation, the principal amount  
8 of \$1,289,591.59 plus interest thereon at a rate of five percent (5%) per annum from the  
9 date of entry of this judgment. Defendant Smith-Emery Company is ordered to pay the  
10 foregoing principal and interest in 120 consecutive monthly installments of \$13,678.12  
11 each, commencing on the date of entry of this judgment, and continuing until paid in full.

13 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that  
14 notwithstanding entry of judgment, the Court shall retain jurisdiction over the parties to  
15 enforce the terms of the parties' settlement and this judgment.
