 21 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, petitioner's Motion for a More Definite  
 22 Statement is HEREBY GRANTED. Respondent is ordered to file a supplemental  
 23 answer to the Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus by a Prisoner in State Custody (28  
 24 U.S.C. § 2254) ("Petition"), Doc. 26, filed Mar. 10, 2010, that complies with Rule 5 of  
 25 the Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases in the United States District Courts.  
 26 Specifically, respondent is ordered to respond to each allegation with sufficient clarity  
 27 and precision that the Court and petitioner may readily identify the material disputed  
 28 facts. Respondent will admit or deny each factual allegation or state the particular

1 reason why he is unable to do so. Respondent will file and serve the supplemental  
2 answer within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order. Within thirty (30) days of  
3 service of the statement, petitioner will file a traverse.
