ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S SECOND EX PARTE APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A REPLY BRIEF

Before the Court is Petitioner Ernest Dewayne Jones' ex parte application for an additional 60-day extension of time to file a reply in support of his opening merits brief on the application of 28 U.S.C. § 2254(d) to the claims in his habeas petition.
